

# MONEY MACHINE INSTRUCTIONS

## YOU WILL RECEIVE:

- ☐ 1 HP Blower Motor  
drawing 10-15 amps
- ☐ 1/8 HP External Huffer  
Drawing 10-15 amps
- ☐ Carrying Bag
- ☐ Safety Glasses
- ☐ Fun Limiter Timer System
- ☐ Stuff-It Pouch
- ☐ Tethers & Carrying Bag
- ☐ (4) Stakes (if on grass)  
Call "Miss Dig" 811 before pounding  
stakes.
- ☐ If on asphalt, weight anchors & tarp.
- ☐ 2 - 12 Gauge extension cords.  
\$75 each if not returned
- ☐ \$75 cleaning fee IF returned  
Wet/Muddy



## YOU NEED:

- Two dedicated 15 amp circuits.
- Adult operator who enforces all rules.

## Installation and Set-Up

Area must be dry and free of debris (ie: sticks, stones, broken glass, etc.)

Remove unit from storage bag.

Position on a dry and clean ground area approximately 10' x 10' for Cash Vault.



### Money Machine must be anchored!

Hammer stake into ground and then tie strap from unit to anchor.

Stake should be within 12 inches from unit to prevent tripping. Stake should be 75% buried at no more than a 30 degree angle.

To test anchor, pull up with a firm lifting force to assure it is secure.

Connect unit to blower tube making sure Velcro strap is firmly secure.



Blower for unit.

Blower for money.



Turn on blower and leave running for period of use.



Plug this blower into the Fun Limiter Timer System.

## Proper Deflation and Return

Remove all participants, take out stakes and unplug blower.

Remove tubes from blowers.

Fold into thirds



ROLL FROM FRONT TO BACK (helps air escape through tubes as you roll it up)

## HOW TO SUPERVISE THIS RIDE:

1. Your organization is taking full responsibility for safe set up and operation of the inflatable as well as the “payout” of prizes.
2. Minimum height requirement: 48”  
Maximum height requirement: 76”  
One participant at a time.
3. If the unit deflates tell participant not to panic and have them exit the ride IMMEDIATELY.  
Then check the plugs and tubes for the cause of air loss.

# HAVE A AND SAFE EVENT

## PATRON RESPONSIBILITY

There are risks in the participation in or on any amusement ride, device or attraction.

Patrons of an amusement ride, device or attraction – by participation – accept the risks which are posted.

Patrons have a duty to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while using the amusement attraction and to obey all oral or written warnings, prior to and during participation.

Patrons have a duty to not participate on any amusement device or attraction while under the influence of drugs or alcohol or due to health conditions.

Patrons have a duty to properly use all safety equipment provided.

**DO NOT ENTER ANY INFLATABLE AMUSEMENT DEVICE  
IF OPERATOR IS NOT PRESENT, RAINING, WIND  
OVER 15-20 MPH, LESS THAN 40 ° OUT, AND AT LEAST  
30 MINUTES AFTER ANY LIGHTNING OR THUNDER.**
