## YOU WILL RECEIVE:

- ☐ 1 - 1.0 H.P. Blower Motor, drawing 10-15 amps
- ☐ Rolled up inflatable ☐ with straps
- ☐ Wheel / Spinner
- ☐ (4) Stakes & Ropes (if on grass)  
Call "Miss Dig" 811 before pounding stakes.
- ☐ If on asphalt, weight anchors & tarp.
- ☐ 12 gauge extension cord, \$75.00 fee if not returned.
- ☐ \$75 cleaning fee IF returned Wet/Muddy



## NO JUMPING ON THIS UNIT - NOT A BOUNCER.

### YOU NEED:

- Dedicated 15 amp circuit.
- Sledge Hammer
- Adult operator who enforces all rules.

## Installation and Set-Up

Area must be dry and free of debris (ie: sticks, stones, broken glass, etc.)

Position on a flat area approximately 22' x 22'

Unroll - you will be unrolling from the back to the front.



### **Twister must be anchored!**

Hammer ASTM approved stake into ground 75% buried, no more than 30 degree angle and then tie strap from unit to anchor.

Stake should be within 12 inches from unit to prevent tripping.

To test anchor, pull up with a firm lifting force to assure it is secure.

Insert blower in either tube, it doesn't make any difference. Use the tube that is closer to the power source, maximum of 50 feet. Tie off the other tube securely. (If not tied already)



Turn on blower and leave running for period of use.  
(inflation takes about 5 minutes)

The Twister unit has a zipper on the back. Be sure to close when inflating!  
(Open to deflate)



## Proper Deflation and Return

Remove all riders and unplug blower. Remove tube from blower and open other tube for deflating only. (Open zipper if your unit has one.)  
Remove ropes from unit and stakes.



Fold into quarters



ROLL FROM FRONT TO BACK (helps air escape through tubes as you roll it up)

## HOW TO SUPERVISE THIS RIDE:

1. **Do not mix younger and older children.**

Limit each ride to allow jumping space for all:

<u>Unit size</u>	<u>Ages:</u>	<u>1 – 6</u>	<u>7 – 11</u>	<u>12 – 17</u>
15' x 15'		6	4	4

2. You must instruct all participants before they enter this ride:

**REMOVE SHOES AND EYEGLASSES**

**NO GUM OR ANY SHARP OBJECT**

**NO FLIPS**

**NO WRESTLING, PILING, HORSEPLAY**

**NO BOUNCING , NOT A JUMPER**

**STAY AWAY FROM THE ENTRANCE**

3. If the unit deflates tell kids not to panic and have them exit the ride IMMEDIATELY.

Check the electrical plugs and tubes for the cause of air loss.

Check blower to see if air intake has been obstructed.

## PATRON RESPONSIBILITY
